AMERICA'S CENTRAL PORT IS STRATEGICALLY LOCATED IN THE HEART OF THE U.S. AND AT THE CONFLUENCE OF THREE MAJOR RIVERS: THE MISSISSIPPI, MISSOURI, AND ILLINOIS.

The Port's North Harbor is the most northerly ice-free port on the Mississippi River, and the Port's South Harbor will be the river's most northerly lock-free port.

Port operators service over 2,500 barges and more than 3.1 million tons of fertilizer, steel, agricultural commodities, and petroleum products each year.

ECONOMIC OUTPUT

THE PORT AND ITS TENANTS IMPACT THE MADISON COUNTY, IL ECONOMY BY PROVIDING GOODS AND SERVICES, EMPLOYING WORKERS, PURCHASING FROM LOCAL SUPPLIERS AND MAKING CAPITAL INVESTMENTS.

America's Central Port is home to more than 70 tenants who employ nearly 900 workers. Each year, the Port and its tenants make business purchases and capital investments that benefit local businesses. These jobs, payroll expenditures, purchases, and investments have a three-part impact on the local economy – a direct impact, an indirect impact, and an induced impact.

In total, America's Central Port and its tenants have an estimated net annual impact of \$555,100,000 on the Madison County economy.

AMERICA'S CENTRAL PORT HAS A SIGNIFICANT IMPACT ON MADISON COUNTY'S EMPLOYMENT, LABOR INCOME, AND TAX BASE

In addition to its impact on the region's total economic output, the Port and its tenants make positive contributions to Madison County's employment, labor compensation, and state and local tax revenue.

The Port's economic impact to Madison County has increased from \$282 million in 2012 to \$555 million in 2020, an increase of ninety-six percent.



EMPLOYMENT

Over 2,460 Jobs

In addition to employees of the Port and its tenants, an estimated 665 indirect and induced jobs result from Port and tenant operations.

LABOR INCOME

\$162.9 million

The employment impact of the Port and its tenants translates into an estimated total labor compensation of \$162,900,000 per year.

TAX BASE

\$9+ million

The Port is a self-supported unit of government, and its tenants generate an estimated \$9,000,000+ annually in state and local tax revenue.
